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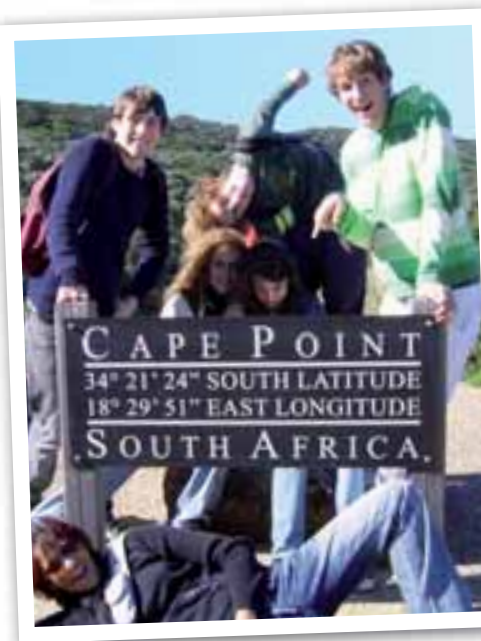

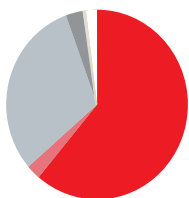

Excursions & Activities

We have an exciting activities programme that allows students to practise the language they learn in the classroom. All activities are supported by activity staff trained to both ensure the safety of the students and to bring the events to life – helping students to enjoy their visit to this beautiful and exciting part of England.



Our daytime excursions include fun afternoons at local attractions, such as the largest water park in England with exciting slides and water flumes, the amazing animals at Paignton Zoo or the miniature wonderland of Babbacombe Model Village. We also hold team challenges such as orienteering or ten-pin bowling, and competitive sports and games.

Our programme also includes trips to discover the local area. A trip to the wilderness of Dartmoor includes a 'letterbox' hunt for hidden stamps. Excursions to cities such as Exeter give our students the chance to explore a wide range of attractions and shops.

Each week we include a full-day excursion to places such as a local leisure park packed with rides and fun. We also take students to other parts of the Westcountry, such as Cornwall, the show caves of Somerset, or a unique collection of historic fairground rides from years gone by.

Our Courses

Lessons at our Summer Schools are designed to be interesting, fun and effective. They have an emphasis on practical, communicative English, focusing on the students' fluency and comprehension using LAL's own course book, written specifically for young learners on a short course, although the full range of disciplines are taught. We seek to ensure that classes are made up of as many different nationalities as possible and that the age range is similar, though students' level is the most important criteria. We accept levels from elementary to advanced.

General English classes have a maximum of 15 students in large, modern, well-equipped classrooms. Students have 20 lessons of 45 minutes each per week.

Trinity GESE exams, and preparation for these exams, are available at all schools, with Intensive English (6 lessons per week in classes of 8) available at Taunton, St Swithun's and St Mary's.

All teachers are qualified, native speakers or native-speaker standard and hold a current certificate in teaching EFL, either Cambridge CELTA or Trinity TESOL (or equivalent according to the British Council).



Activities

Adventure

Kelly College has its own adventure centre, where students can try canoeing, climbing and other exciting outdoor activities. Horse riding is available at Kelly College and at Taunton School.

Tennis

St Swithun's focuses on tennis, with coaching by professionals available along with a trip to Wimbledon.

Football

Taunton School features professional football coaching and extra football-based English lessons.

Sports

At all of our schools there are fields and sports halls for football, rugby, volleyball, tennis, basketball, badminton and even cricket! Our staff run matches and competitions throughout the course.

Arts

St Mary's is home to our creative arts programme with a wide range of activities including film-making, art, drama and trips to arts venues in London.

Something for Everyone

Our schools offer karaoke, disco, drama, dance, singing, radio-controlled car racing, cashless casino nights and films as further options to keep everyone entertained. Each has a popular talent show where staff and students can impress the school.





Excursions

All our schools are within easy reach of a wide range of attractions. To complement the varied on-site activities, we have an extensive excursion programme, incorporating both culture and fun, taking in popular cultural and entertainment destinations where the students are actively encouraged to use their English.

Additional excursions and activities are available for an extra charge on request and students who stay for longer than two weeks will receive an additional full-day excursion as part of their programme.



Food and Accommodation

All our summer schools offer a balanced diet of wholesome food to make sure that students are well fed.

Each summer school has a good standard of accommodation, with boys and girls in separate areas. Accommodation ranges from traditional British boarding school dormitories to single rooms.

Welfare

We consider the safety of our students to be of the highest importance and it is our policy to have designated staff, experienced in working with young people, living in our residences, available to students twenty-four hours a day. All our staff are checked for their suitability to work with juniors according to current British legislation. We offer groups and individual students our high level of welfare.

London

St Mary's University College



Ages 13-17

St Mary's is a modern university campus and was founded in 1850. The campus is based in Strawberry Hill, Twickenham, the home of Rugby's most important stadium. Located by the river Thames, Twickenham has a busy High Street with many shops and cafés offering good connections by public transport to Central London, with all manner of attractions for students. St Mary's hosts our Creative Arts School with extra lessons including film making, drama and other creative arts.

A multi-million Pound renovation project has brought Strawberry Hill's Walpole Villa, the cornerstone of the St Mary's campus, back to its 18th century magnificence. St Mary's is only a 10 minute walk to the centre of Twickenham and the River Thames.

Activities and Excursions

St Mary's has a new £8million sports centre, indoor sports hall, indoor tennis courts and a cinema room plus extensive fields for outdoor sports, including a marked football/hockey pitch. A wide range of activities are held on site to entertain students and help them practise their English through integration.

Each two-week period includes two full-day and four half-day excursions, including sightseeing tours of London with visits to the BBC & Movie Museum as well as other London sights, plus an evening boat disco on the River Thames. There are also optional trips available to other towns and places of interest, theme parks and sites such as Stonehenge at extra cost.

Accommodation

The college is made up of five separate accommodation houses on the campus, with single rooms and shared or private bathrooms.

Taunton

Taunton is a town in the south west of England, with a population of around 58,000 and is within an hour of three world heritage sites, as well as being just three and a half hours from London. It has a busy town centre with lots of different kinds of shops selling everything from trendy jeans to old books, with a number of cafés, sandwich shops and restaurants.

Just ten minutes' walk from the town centre, Taunton School is an independent school with excellent sports facilities.

Behind its magnificent architecture, Taunton School provides modern facilities including modern classrooms, two heated swimming pools, sports fields, outside tennis courts, and three high-quality sports halls.

Activities and Excursions

Students have the opportunity to take part in a large number of activities, all within the school's extensive grounds. Four excursions are included every two weeks, including an excursion to London and other famous places such as Stonehenge, legendary Glastonbury and Oxford to see Christ Church college, whose interior inspired the Harry Potter films. There are also optional excursions to theme parks and other places of interest.

Football Course and Horse-riding

We run an optional Football course with qualified English Football Association coaches leading the sessions, improving skills and strategies for this global game. We also offer horse-riding at local stables as an optional activity. Both of these are at extra cost.

Accommodation

Students stay in typical English boarding school residences in shared rooms. There are comfortable common rooms with indoor games and study areas. Boys and girls stay in separate houses.

Kelly College, with its evocative main building, is situated on the outskirts of the picturesque market town of Tavistock, on the edge of Dartmoor National Park in south west England.

Our new schedule of activities means that students of all ages can enjoy the excitement of outdoors pursuits under the supervision of professional, qualified instructors.

Activities and Excursions

The heated indoor swimming pool and extensive grounds give students the opportunity to enjoy a variety of sports and activities. Our leisure programme includes a wide range of sporting, artistic and stimulating activities, excursions to some fantastic local destinations such as the amazing Eden Project, the supposed ruins of King Arthur's Castle at Tintagel and a half-day at the Kelly College Adventure Centre.

Adventure Centre and Horse-riding

The Adventure Centre is always popular - kayaking, abseiling, archery, rafting and a high ropes course are just some of the activities students are able to select to test their sense of adventure. Activities & Excursions

Our centre is on The Strand in the popular seaside town of Sliema. It has undergone a major refurbishment programme to create a teenagers' learning environment which is second to none. The centre has an open-plan lounge and reception with a large plasma screen, 60 bright and airy classrooms, vending machines for drinks and snacks and a large courtyard where students can enjoy their lunch and mix with their fellow students. Our team of academic, leisure and welfare co-ordinators guarantee a smooth operation and a pleasant experience for the students.

What's included?

Courses

Wildlife Experience

The Wildlife Experience Camp takes place at Ilkley in the Greater Kruger National Park. The camp is right in the heart of the bush scrub, with a camp fire for evening activities and storytelling. There is also a big-screen and entertainment area, a large swimming pool and 'boma'.

There are 15 informal lessons every week. Lessons have a strong wildlife and ecology theme, and include on site conservation and ecology training with qualified game rangers, an introduction to African fauna and flora, a senses activity to explore human and animal senses, and even wildlife safaris.

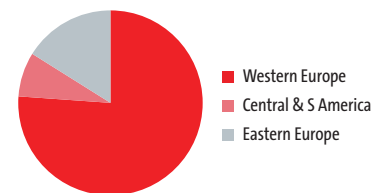

Activities & Excursions

1. Definitions

In these terms and conditions, the following terms have the meanings set out next to them (and references to the singular include the plural and vice-versa):

Agreement	These terms and conditions together with the Application Form and the Price List which are supplied by the Supplier School.
Application Form:	The form you complete and send to the Supplier School in connection with applying for a place on a Course which shall be considered to form an integral part of this Agreement.
Confirmation Form:	The form the Supplier School sends you to confirm acceptance of your application.
Course:	The Course of study you have applied for on your Application Form offered by the Supplier School.
Departure Date:	The date on which your Course ends.
LAL Language Centres:	The language centres at various locations identified in the Price List.
Price List:	The document entitled 'Price List' which incorporates the Application Form and these terms and conditions and which is also downloadable from the Website and which shall be considered to form an integral part of this Agreement
Relevant Account:	The Supplier School's bank account identified in the Price List.
Start Date:	The first day of the Course for which you are applying.
Supplier School:	The LAL Language Centre in the location where you wish to study identified in the Price List.
Website:	The Website at www.lalgroup.com
You/Your:	The applicant for a Course at the Supplier School.

2. Agreement

This Agreement shall be legally binding between you and the Supplier School once the Supplier School has received a completed Application Form from you, whether by e-mail or otherwise, and has confirmed your place by sending you a Confirmation Form. This Agreement and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with it or its validity or its subject matter or formation is governed by and construed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the legal jurisdiction in which the Supplier School is situated.

3. Payment

Full payment must be received by the Supplier School not less than 14 days before your Start Date. You will not be allowed to commence your Course if payment is not made by that time. Payment may be made by bank transfer, credit or debit card or in person to the Relevant Account. Additional charges may apply depending on the choice of payment medium and such charges are identified on the Price List.

4. Prices

All prices stated on the Price List are valid from 01 January 2011 to 31 December 2011. LAL Language Centres reserve the right to unilaterally change prices as a result of governmental regulations, tax increases, exchange rate variations or other events.

5. Changes and Amendments

Once you have started a Course, no changes may be made to it other than by written agreement from the Supplier School. If the Supplier School opts to approve a change, the additional charge which is specified in the Price List will be incurred by you.

6. Cancellations

You may cancel your booking provided you do so by written notice to the Supplier School, which it must receive not less than 14 days before the Start Date. In such an event, any fees you have paid will be refunded except for registration fees and one week's tuition and (where applicable) accommodation fees (such fees being specified in the Price List). If you cancel your booking less than 14 days before the Start Date, any refunds are entirely at the Supplier School General Manager's discretion. A full refund of all fees paid (less delivery charges) will be made in the event of visa refusal provided you send written notice to the Supplier School and documentary evidence of such refusal. If a Course is terminated after the Start Date, or if you fail to present yourself at the school on the Start Date without having previously cancelled your Course, no refunds will be given on tuition and accommodation.

7. Courses

Start Dates are detailed in the Price List. In the event of an insufficient number of students booking for a particular Course, the Supplier School reserves the right to cancel the Course or provide you with an alternative Course which the Supplier School, in its sole discretion, considers suitable.

8. Lesson Times

Indicative lesson times are set out in the Price List. The Supplier School reserves the right to alter such lesson times at its discretion.

9. Competency Levels

Courses are offered at six levels of language learning: False beginner/Elementary/ Pre-intermediate/Intermediate/Upper Intermediate and Advanced. A special programme for complete beginners is offered only on the first Monday of every month at each LAL Language Centre. Other teaching levels may be available by arrangement.

10. Certification

You must attend a minimum of 80% of lessons scheduled for the Course in order to receive a certificate of attendance at its conclusion.

11. School Closures

National holidays and school closure dates may vary according to location and are detailed in the Price List. No reductions are made to prices in respect of closures on such dates.

12. Accommodation

LAL Language Centres are happy to advise you on a variety of accommodation options. You should book accommodation for the Start Date until the day before your Departure Date unless you are informed to the contrary by the Supplier School. Accommodation arrangements are your responsibility unless you indicate that you wish to book accommodation with the Supplier School on your Application Form.

13. Travel & Transfers

Course fees do not include flights or other transport to the Supplier School, except where specified. You must make your own travel arrangements. The Supplier School will offer transfers from your airport of arrival to your accommodation ("Transfers") subject to the payment of an additional charge. You must indicate whether you wish to reserve a Transfer on your Application Form and provide the Supplier School with full details of your flight and arrival time at least 7 days before your Start Date (failure to do so or any extra costs incurred by the Supplier School as a result of incorrect, delayed or inadequate information provided by you or your delayed arrival at the relevant airport may result in your incurring further charges).

14. Visas

Depending upon the location of the Supplier School, you may require a visa to study in such location. The Supplier School will assist you in connection with your initial application for a visa but in all other respects it is your responsibility to apply for and obtain a visa where necessary.

15. Immigration Regulations

You must ensure that you fully understand immigration regulations in the Supplier School's location. It is your responsibility to ensure that you meet and comply with any such regulations and the Supplier School will not refund any fees paid due to your having been refused entry into the Supplier School's location by immigration authorities.

16. Health

You must be in good physical and mental health at the Start Date and the Supplier School reserves the right to require you to leave any Course at your own expense in the event that you fail to declare any material matters relating to your health on the Application Form.

17. Insurance and Limitation of Liability

The illegal use of drugs, alcohol abuse and inconsiderate behaviour is unacceptable as is any failure by you to abide by the law and custom of the Supplier School's location. The Supplier School reserves the right to withhold Courses and accommodation from any student who fails to meet such standards and to terminate any Course or part thereof without refund in appropriate circumstances.

20. Expulsion
